

Dear Parents.

I am looking forward to a year full of new learning experiences for the children as well as myself.

Please note the following information, as this will ease your child's transition into Kindergarten:

- 1) School begins on Thursday, September 7<sup>th</sup>. Your child should be in the school yard by 8:00 a.m.
- 2) I will be setting up and using the app Classroom DOJO for the school year. I'd like to have that set up prior to school beginning. At least one or both parents should sign up. This app will help keep you informed on day to day happenings.

## 3) Arrival and dismissal

- (a) Dismissal time for Thursday the 7th, and Friday, the 8<sup>th</sup>, will be at 12:00pm.
- (b) If your child is going home by car, you will need to stay in your car and drive to Mortimer Ave. There will be two teachers to assist your child with getting to your car. Please do not park or get out of the car to wait. We ask that you put a sign on your dashboard with your child's first and last name and grade they are in to help the process go smoothly. Please make sure the paper is big enough and written clearly with dark marker.
- (c) Please send your child with a lunch both days.

## 3) Going Home Sheet

- (a) Enclosed you will find an information sheet for your child to have for the first 2 days of school. Please print your child's name, mode of transportation and the name of the person(s) who will accompany your child to and from school. Please include a number you can be reached at in the case of an emergency and place it in your child's folder. This note will be for the first 3 days only.
- (b) If your child is to leave school on any given day by a different mode of transportation or with a different person than his or her letter indicates, school policy requires that I be notified in writing of the change.
- (c) Please fill out the sheet and place it in your child's folder for the first day of school.





## <u>Supplies</u>

- (a) On the first day of school children should bring the following items:
  - 1. school bag
  - 2. 1 box of Crayola crayons (64 count)
  - 3. one box of thick Crayola washable markers (please do not get thin markers or Mr. Sketch scented markers)
  - 4. 1 pair of scissors (preferably Fiskars)
  - 5. 2 two pocket folders
  - 6. 4 large glue sticks
  - 7. 1 eraser
  - 8. 3 rolls of paper towels
  - 9. 4 containers of antibacterial wipes or baby wipes
  - 10.1 bottle of Elmer's glue
  - 11. 1 smock (a big old shirt would be great)
  - 12.2 boxes of tissues
  - 13.1 package of "My First" TICONDEROGA pencils
  - 14.1 package of POST-IT self-stick note 3x3 count 100, or similar in size
  - 15. 2 reams of white copy paper  $8.5 \times 11$
- (b) Notebooks and supply boxes will be purchased in school. You will be notified of the price in September.
- (c) Please be sure to write your child's name on all of these items, as well as on all articles of clothing.
- (d) Please do not send in anything that is not on the list, (example: a pencil case, colored pencils, or notebooks). The supplies above are all the materials the children will need.
